

Paper Requirements

The author should submit a 2-4 pages long extended abstract of the report in Word text editor for Windows. The pagemargins – 2 cm overall, Times New Roman, 14 pt for the text, single space between lines, paragraph indent – 1 cm. Type of quotation marks – «», apostrophe – (’), language – Ukrainian or English.

If the text contains references to cited and used sources, they should be given at the end of the main text according to the alphabet under the heading «List of References». Style of citation: APA 6th ed. format.
