REQUIREMENTS FOR THESIS REPORT PREPARATION:

➤ Thesis report must be saved as the **Microsoft Word 2003** document, on an A4 sheet (210x297 mm), margins (mm): top – 20, bottom – 20, left – 25, right – 10.

➤ **Font** – Times New Roman, **font size** – 14, **paragraph** – 1.25 cm, **line spacing** – 1, **style** – Normal;

➤ On the first line, on the left, the section number is indicated, below - UDC. After 1 interval on the right, information about the author is indicated: surname, first name and patronymic (in full), scientific degree, academic title, name of the educational institution. Next, in the center, the name of the thesis report is indicated in bold, after which the text is presented;

➤ Tables should be concise, clear and must contain the minimum information necessary to illustrate the essence of the report. **The name of the table:** Times

New Roman, font size 14, bold, without paragraph indentation, center aligned, offsets from above and below - 6 pt.

➤ **Captions to figures:** Times New Roman, font size 14, bold, without paragraph indentation, center aligned.

➤ **The font in tables and figures** is Times New Roman, font size 12, regular, single line spacing.

➤ The **references list** should contain only the sources to which there are references in the text; example of link references design: [1, p. 127]. References in parentheses to various sources should be separated by semicolons [1, p. 128; 2, p. 55-56].

➤ The references list should be drawn up taking into account State standard of Ukraine 8302:2015 "Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General provisions and rules of drafting".
